Real Flight Experience



I'm deeply grateful to have received the Grand Champion Silver Award in the Aerosim Interschool Aviation Tournament (AIAT) 2024.

As part of the award, I was privileged to receive sponsorship covering half the cost of a real flight training trip to Melbourne, Australia, from December 24 – 30, 2024.

During the trip, I studied crucial aspects of aviation. In addition to controlling the aircraft, we learned about weather conditions, flight planning, and communication with air traffic controllers. I spent considerable time at Moorabbin Airport, the general aviation airport where the training took place. Besides flying, I visited the hangar and toured the Air Traffic Control tower; additionally, I experienced a 7-axis motion simulator, which was highly realistic and enabled me to practice risky maneuvers safely.

Of course, the “main course” of the trip was the flight experience. We had briefing sessions before and after each flight to introduce the lesson's focus and review our performance. The lessons I completed included Effects of Controls, Straight and Level, Climbing and Descending, and Medium-Level Turns. However, I was never alone in the aircraft; there was always an instructor seated beside me, providing guidance. Nonetheless, I still had ample opportunities to control the aircraft, feeling the world move around me.

Flying in the cockpit wasn't as daunting as I had imagined, as there were clear instructions on what to do. Things went smoothly after repeated practice. For example, when I performed level turns, I kept losing altitude at first. Thankfully, the instructor guided me expertly on how to apply back pressure properly, and eventually, I could maintain altitude!

Overall, this trip was a valuable experience for me, as I learned a lot about the aviation field, including the pathway and knowledge required to become a pilot. This will be a memorable journey that I will never forget. I also want to express gratitude to my school for providing me this opportunity, and to Mr. Lee and my fellow teammates during the AIAT competition. I wouldn't have had this experience without their relentless support.

Last but not least, “Dreams don't work unless you do.” Aviation, like any dream, takes effort and courage. It starts with learning the theory, understanding the controls, and practicing repeatedly — often through failure, but always with purpose.

The 19th Infrastructure Building Competition for Secondary Schools 2025 - 1st Runner Up

This year, our school sent two teams to the 19th Infrastructure Building Competition for Secondary Schools 2025, achieving commendable results. Prior to constructing our unique models, we designed and tested prototypes in the Design & Technology room. Our goal was to create earthquake-resistant, flexible structures with visually appealing designs. The competition was challenging, as each team was limited to 25 wooden sticks and two adhesives for assembly. Despite these constraints, our teams methodically constructed their models.



During the semi-final, our models underwent a deflection test on a horizontal platform, where weights were gradually added to one end. The model with the least deflection scored the highest. Remarkably, our teams secured 4th and 8th places out of 148 teams, advancing to the final.

In the final, our models were tested on a shaking platform simulating an earthquake. Although neither model passed the loading test, one was awarded the Best Design Model 1st Runner-up. This competition was more than a contest; it was an exploration of model construction and structural mechanics. From drafting designs to receiving the award, our dedication paid off. The experience deepened our understanding of engineering principles and fostered teamwork. Undoubtedly, this competition broadened our perspectives in engineering.

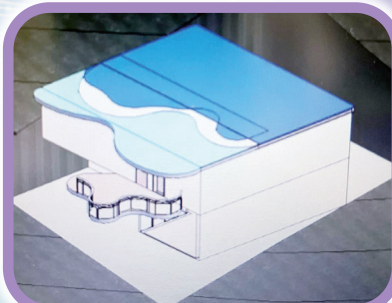
'Your Dream Home' Building Information Modelling (BIM) Competition 2024 - 2nd Runner-up and two Merits

In this competition, participants attended a series of BIM training workshops to equip students with knowledge and skills in BIM, and its applications in architectural design, interior design, landscape design and sustainable building design.

With concerted effort, we overcame the obstacles, and all three teams from our school were awarded: a 2nd Runner-up and two Merits.

STREAM Week - 6/5/2025 to 9/5/2025

In the *One-minute to Freeze* activity, participants rolled a can of coke on ice for just one minute to rapidly cool it. The principle behind this is simple yet clever: rolling the can increases the liquid's contact area with the aluminium, enhancing heat transfer and achieving a quick chilling effect. Watching participants' excitement as they felt the cans turn ice-cold in their hands was incredibly rewarding. It was a perfect blend of fun and science, demonstrating thermal conductivity in an accessible way. I'm thrilled to see how this simple activity sparked curiosity and left everyone refreshed with their chilled drinks!

Besides, the *Cracking Exhibition* was equally captivating, utilizing a prism to showcase refraction and total internal reflection. Participants used a laser pointer to navigate light through the prism, aiming to hit a sensor target. The challenge of aligning the laser just right to trigger the sensor was both thrilling and educational, turning complex optical principles into an interactive game. Seeing participants' faces light up as they successfully "cracked" the challenge was a highlight of the event. It was a fantastic way to make abstract concepts tangible and exciting.

In the last few days, I am glad that I could be a helper of the STREAM week. I participated in the *Reflex Challenge* and the *Riddle Corner*. Many students and teachers joined us and enjoyed the fun of STREAM week. In Reflex challenge, electromagnets and parallel circuit are used, while each stick is held up by the electromagnets and controlled by a switch. But how does this system work?

The electromagnets are made by passing electric current through the wire which is wrapped by iron, creating magnetic fields that attract the iron clips with the sticks. Users turn off the switch to make an open circuit, causing the iron clips to fall. The whole system is connected with a parallel circuit, allowing us to control each electromagnet independently so that we can drop the sticks one by one. This challenge also requires students to have quick reaction times — it measures how long it takes students to respond to a signal. Another very simple way to measure reaction time is testing with a dropping ruler.

Also, I was involved in the *Riddle Corner*. While reading some passages, students are required to guess the answer to the riddles. The riddles are all about the content in the 'STREAM Week — Topic of the Month'. After the STREAM week, I learned lots of STREAM knowledge in a very interesting way. It is also my honour to be a part of STREAM week. I look forward to the next STREAM week!

Recently, I participated in an activity of making leaf vein bookmarks during STREAM Week as a helper. Here are the steps of how to make a leaf vein bookmark. First, prepare some Osmanthus leaves and soak them in boiled NaOH (sodium hydroxide) and Na₂CO₃ (sodium carbonate) solution with a ratio of 5:1 for 5 minutes. Then wash the leaves with water. Finally, you can start to brush the leaf gently with a toothbrush to remove all the leaf flesh. After that, you will get a leaf skeleton. You can decorate it or just laminate it.

I was very glad that all the participants enjoyed this activity and decorated their bookmarks beautifully. I look forward to teaching others how to make leaf vein bookmarks again in the STREAM Week!

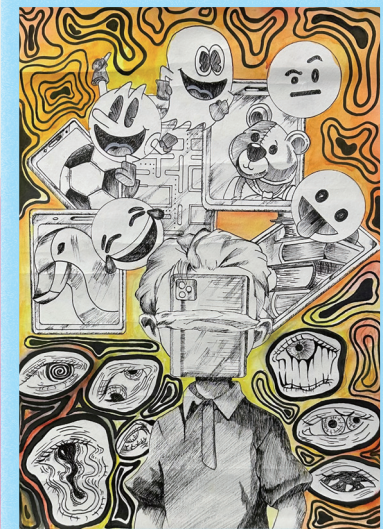

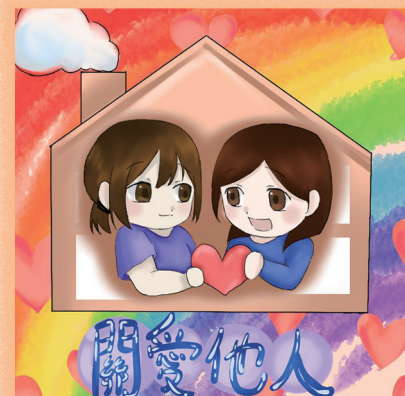
