
I was 11 years old when I first touched the piano keys on the piano. My music teacher encouraged us to choose an instrument to play to develop a sense of harmony. To be honest, I really enjoyed playing the piano, as it proved to be the perfect way to express my feelings and emotions. However, trying to strike a harmonious balance between my academics and my musical passion was definitely difficult. Despite my efforts to hone my skills, my mother, concerned about the impact of my musical pursuits on my academic performance, implored me to withdraw from my piano lessons.

Two years later, while in the midst of my fourth year of secondary school, I found myself captivated by the graceful melodies from the masterful performance of the famous pianist Lang Lang on TV. In that enchanting moment, my deep love for the piano was rekindled. Determined to play the piano again, I began to practice nonstop. I discovered that I had forgotten several vital techniques, including pedaling. To regain my skills, I started with a relatively simpler composition: the first movement of Beethoven's Moonlight Sonata. Although it seemed simple, it took a staggering eight months of practice before I could successfully play the entire piece.

I also gained a new skill: playing expressively with emotions. In the past, I simply followed the notes on the sheet without considering how to make playing the music enjoyable. I discovered that the most important thing is understanding the true meaning of the piece. If I wanted to play even better than I did in primary school, I had to approach the piano differently. I found that between the black and white keys lay a colourful emotional world. I played the piece countless times with varying loudness and speed to find the best way to convey my emotions. After this

piece, I chose numerous compositions like Nocturne and Suffocation to practice. Initially, I chose them for their melodious qualities, but each helped me to correct my weaknesses. My practice became quicker and more effective.

When my music teacher Miss Cheung sought participants for the Hong Kong Schools Music Festival, I seized the opportunity to prove that I had made progress



in my piano skills. Yet, the process was not easy. I encountered countless obstacles, including memorizing the piece and conveying its emotions to listeners. So, I practiced hard from day to night in order to achieve my best.


New Chinese Language Teacher at CCCKYC - Ms. Wan Po Yan, Agnes
