Principal's Message

LOVE NEVER FAILS

The 2022–2023 school year celebrates the 40th anniversary of CCC Kei Yuen College. We are grateful for God's direction throughout the years and the 40 years of blessings that the school has enjoyed. We want to share the experience of God's bountiful grace upon every student and teacher as well as our entire school with everyone.

40 years of God's grace

CCC Kei Yuen College was founded in 1982 and is the 21st secondary school of the Council Board. Over the past 40 years, there have been 11 supervisors and 4 principals, all of whom have upheld the school according to the spirit of the Council Board's mission of 'Missionary Service through School'. Furthermore, the school adheres to the Council's guiding principle of giving students a quality Christian education built on the concept of 'whole-person education', with an emphasis on nurturing life, shaping students' values and maximising their potential. There is an old proverb, 'It takes ten years to grow a tree, but a hundred years to build a man'. In the last 40 years, with God's guidance and the direction and instruction of our previous superintendents, principals and teachers, we have raised generations of excellent students; to date, we have produced outstanding alumni who have made significant contributions to society and the country.

"Oh, that you would bless me and enlarge my territory! "

Owing to God's blessing, CCC Kei Yuen College has grown over 40 years like the prayer of Jabez in the Bible, "Oh, that you would bless me and enlarge my territory! " (1 Chronicles 4: 10 NIV). With God's grace and infinite blessings, the school has continued to broaden its sphere, thereby enlarging its area, building student capacity and expanding the work of the Gospel.

Enlarging the school area

Because a large area of undeveloped land next to the school has been overgrown for many years, CCC Kei Yuen College formally applied to the government in 2001 for the allocation of the adjacent land for school development. However, the application process was challenging due to the laborious interdepartmental application process, significant expenditure needed to grade the vacant land, difficulties in moving underground drains, etc. After 16 years of hard work and with God's blessing, in 2017, the school was finally able to lease the nearby vacant land from the government for sports and recreational

activities. This allowed the school to expand and have the largest recreational area in Yuen Long, thereby giving students more room to participate in sports and extracurricular activities.

Building students' abilities

CCC Kei Yuen College has dedicated itself to improving students' English proficiency for years. With the implementation of the fine-tuning of the Medium of Instruction (MOI) policy in 2010-2011, the Education Bureau approved our transition from a mixed medium of instruction to English. Commencing in September 2010, we used English as the main medium of instruction in all S1 classes. This shift heralds a new era of the school and equips our students with the language skills necessary to excel in their education. Years of efforts by the school finally paid off. Since then, the school has continued to make efforts to improve students' English ability, thereby allowing the school to become one of the schools using English as the main medium of instruction in all classes in Yuen Long. The school has produced numerous outstanding students over the years and enabled them to make significant academic strides. We thank God for bringing out the best in our students.

Expanding the work of the Gospel

Dedicated to church–school cooperation for years under the auspices of the District Council, the Hong Kong Council of the Church of Christ in China and CCC Kei Yuen College have spared no effort to promote the Gospel in the school and enabled the development of the evangelical programme by imparting religious education to children.

After years of preparation, in 2014, Kei Yuen Church was established in the school to spread the Gospel and nurture children.

Looking to the future: Education of love

Due to God's blessing, the school has grown in all aspects. Looking ahead, following the vision of the District Council, 'shoulder to shoulder, we nurture life; hand in hand, we share God's love', CCC Kei Yuen College will continue to deliver quality education and nurture life to allow students to grow in love, know Jesus Christ, be blessed and bring glory to God. Amen.

2022/23學年是中華基督教會基元中學40周年校慶的大日子，我們以哥林多前書13章8節「愛是永不止息」(Love Never Fails) 為題，進行一連串的慶祝活動，感恩上帝的愛及多年來的帶領，學校經歷了40年的祝福，要向所有人見證上帝豐厚的恩典，是如何充充足足的臨在於這個地方及每一位師生的身上。

40年的恩典

基元中學於1982年創校，是區會創立的第21所中學，40年來總共有11位校監及4位校長以區會的辦學精神「透過學校，傳道服務」帶領學校發展。學校又秉承區會的辦學理念，以「全人教育」為藍本，提供優質的基督教教育，並以培育生命為重任，塑造學生的品德及發展他們的潛能。古語有云：「十年樹木，百年樹人」，40年來在上帝的帶領下，與及歷任校監、校長及教師的循循善誘及教導，栽培一代又一代的基元學生，至今已有不少出色的校友，貢獻社會及國家。

「甚願你賜福與我，擴張我的境界」

感謝上帝的賜福，基元中學40年來的發展就好像聖經中雅比斯的禱告，「甚願你賜福與我，擴張我的境界」（歷代志上4章10節）一樣，得著上帝的恩典及祝福，不斷擴張境界，包括擴張學校的面積；擴張學生的能力；與及擴張福音的工作。

擴張學校的面積

有見學校鄰近的一大片空地多年來空置及雜草叢生，基元中學於2001年正式向政府申請將鄰地撥作學校發展用途，但申請過程困難重重，包括繁複的跨部門申請程序，平整空地的龐大支出，與及地底水渠重置的困難等等，歷經16載的努力，感謝上主的眷顧，終於2017年成功向政府租借鄰近空地作為學校運動及休憩場地，擴張

了學校的地積境界，使學校成為元朗區坐擁最大休閒用地面積的學校，讓學生有更多空間發展體育及課外活動。

擴張學生的能力

基元中學多年來致力提升學生的英語能力，於2010年得到教育局確認，符合資格，正式在中一全級採用英語授課，是全體教師多年來努力的成果（當年全港只有16間中學能夠符合資格由中一開始轉為全以英語授課）。自此之後，學校繼續提升學生的英語能力，成功推動學校轉型，成為元朗區其中一所以英語授課的中學之一，多年來，孕育無數尖子，讓學生在學術成績上不斷突破，感謝天父讓學生的能力得以擴張。

擴張福音的工作

在區會的推動下，中華基督教會元朗堂與基元中學多年來均致力堂校合作，在發展校內福音工作上不遺餘力，有見福音的幼苗雖多，但能茁壯地在教會成長的甚少，所以促成了「校牧事工」計劃的發展，經過多年的籌備，最終於2014年成功在校內建立堂會，命名為中華基督教會基元堂，與學校更緊密地合作在校內傳揚福音，栽培幼苗，擴張校內的福音工作及禾場。

展望未來——愛的教育

感謝天父的祝福，學校各方面的境界得以擴張，展望未來，基元中學將會實踐區會的辦學願景「並肩培育豐盛生命 攜手見證基督大愛」，繼續提供優質教育，關愛及培育學生的生命素質，讓每一位學生都能在愛中成長，認識耶穌基督，得着福音的確據，將一切榮耀歸給上帝，阿們。
